

**By-laws of**  
**Kingsley Bowmen**

**Article I.**

**Mission Statement**

**Kingsley Bowmen** is a club dedicated to the advancement of archery and bow hunting in our community and to promote archery education and opportunity for our youth.

**Article II.**

**Meetings**

Meetings shall be held the first Tuesday of each month at the **Kingsley Bowmen** range and shall be called to order by the President.

Special meetings shall be called at the discretion of the President.

The annual election of officers shall be held at the regular March club meeting.

All meetings are to be conducted in accordance with Roberts Rules of Order.

All matters shall be voted upon by the membership in attendance at a regular meeting.

**Article III.**

**Annual dues**

Membership dues shall be for an individual membership \$100 per year and a Family membership \$150.00 per year. The family membership will apply to a spouse and all children in the immediate family under 18 years of age. Associate Membership \$35.00 per year and shall apply to anyone who lives 50 miles or more outside the Klamath Falls city limits and is a current member of another archery club (membership can be in or from another state).

Dues become delinquent the first day after the month of renewal. Renewal month is set for March of every year.

Only paid up members shall be allowed to use the facilities. Members not in good standing will be asked to not use the facilities until they return to good standing.

The combination to the cipher lock will be given to all Members in good standing; members shall not give the combination to anyone.

The cipher lock combination will be randomly changed at the discretion of the executive board to prevent misuse of the facilities, when the combination is changed the executive board will ensure all members in good standing receive the new combination immediately.

Members in good standing who reach age 65 shall become paid up life members.

Target leagues shall be coordinated with the executive board of directors and all fees shall be set at the regular meeting prior to the event.

## **Article IV.**

### **Fiscal authorizations**

Expenditures of \$100 or less may be appropriated and approved by a single member of the executive board. Expenditures between \$100 to \$1000 must be approved by a majority vote of the executive board. Expenditures of more than \$1000 must be approved by a majority vote of paid members in attendance at a regular meeting. The treasurer shall keep records in accordance with general accounting practices.

## **Article V.**

### **Tournaments and leagues**

The **Kingsley Bowmen** will hold at least 2 public shoots each year. Rules and fees for these events shall be approved by a majority vote of members in good standing at the planning meeting for these events. The Tournament Director will form committees to draft plans and carry out club tournaments and leagues. The events and all leagues will be open to the public.

## **Article VI.**

### **Executive Board and Club Officers**

The Executive Board shall consist of 5 members, President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Tournament Director. This shall also be the order of authority to preside over general meetings in the absence of one or more preeminent board members. Club Officer positions shall consist of 8 members, Awards Director, Target Director, Donation/Raffle Director, Food/Banquet Director, Publicity Director, Youth Director, Range Master and Member at Large. The officer positions are intended to provide information, direction and coordination to the executive board, and will be used as a committee to enhance specific duties within the club.

## **Article VII.**

### **By-law amendments**

These by-laws may be amended by a two thirds majority vote of members in good standing present at any regular meeting.
